



Twist to the Classic Beanie.



An Original Crochet Pattern by

Skill Level: Beginner

Materials:

- 5 mm crochet hook
- Light worsted weight yarn
- Pompom (optional)
- Scissors
- Darning needle

Stitches and terms used:

- ch- chain
- sl st- slip stitch
- sc- single crochet
- hdc- half double crochet
- dc- double crochet
- puff st- puff stitch
- rpt- repeat

Gauge: 15 sts & 7 rows in dc= 4”

Notes:

- Read through the pattern from beginning to end before starting your work just to be sure don't have any questions that might cause frustration while working on the project.
- Please check your gauge and adjust as needed to achieve correct sizing.
- The pattern is worked in BLO- Back Loop Only.
- Ch 3 counts as a st where as the ch 1 doesn't count as a stitch.
- Stitch count for each size remains the same throughout the pattern.
- Hat has a bit of stretch so the actual finished circumference and fit (listed below) may differ by a few inches.
- The Twist to the Classic Beanie is worked flat in rows and seamed together when finished. One end is closed to form the top of the beanie

and the other end is folded up to form the brim.

- The pattern has been split into 3 clusters; Baby, Child & Adult. Refer to the table below for the sizes under each cluster.
- The number in parenthesis () at the end of each row represents the total number of stitches to be worked in each row.
- Photos for reference are attached at the end of pattern instructions.

Hat sizing chart for reference:

Approximate amount of yarn needed:

- **Baby-** 100 yards
- **Child-** 150 yards
- **Adult-** 230 yards

Pattern:

Baby.

Newborn- 3 months (3- 6 months, 6-12 months)

With your worsted weight yarn and 5 mm hook,

Ch 27 (27, 27)

Row 1: dc in 4th ch from hook. Dc in each of the next 3 ch, dc2tog twice, dc in each of the next 3 ch, 2 dc in each of the next 2 ch. Dc in each of the next 3 ch, hdc2tog twice, sc in in the next 3 chs, 2 sc in last ch. (24 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn. 2 sc in the 1st st, sc in each of the next 3 sts, hdc2tog twice, dc in the next 3 sts, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts, dc in each of the next 3 sts, dc2tog twice. Dc in each of the next 3 sts, 2 dc on top of the ch 3. (24 sts)

Row 3: ch 3, turn. Dc in 1st st. Dc in each of the next 3 sts, dc2tog twice, dc in each of the next 3 sts, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts. Dc in each of the next 3 sts, hdc2tog twice, sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in last st. (24 sts)

Row 4- 20 (22, 24): Rpt row 2-3

Move to closing & finishing.

Child.

1- 3 years (3- 5 years, 5- 10 years)

With your worsted weight yarn and 5 mm hook,

Ch 39 (39, 39)

Row 1: dc in 4th ch from hook, (dc in each of the next 3 ch, dc2tog twice, dc in each of the next 3 ch, 2 dc in each of the next 2 ch) 2 times. Dc in each of the next 3 ch,

hdc2tog twice, sc in in the next 3 chs, 2 sc in last ch. (36 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn. 2 sc in the 1st st, sc in each of the next 3 sts, hdc2tog twice, (dc in the next 3 sts, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts, dc in each of the next 3 sts, dc2tog twice) 2 times, dc in each of the next 3 sts, 2 dc on top of the ch 3. (36 sts)

Row 3: ch 3, turn. Dc in 1st st, (dc in each of the next 3 sts, dc2tog twice, dc in each of the next 3 sts, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts) 2 times. Dc in each of the next 3 sts, hdc2tog twice, sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in last st. (36 sts)

Row 4- 26 (28, 30): Rpt row 2-3

Adult.

Teen/ Adult Small (Adult Large)

With your worsted weight yarn and 5 mm hook,

Ch 51 (51)

Row 1: dc in 4th ch from hook, (dc in each of the next 3 ch, dc2tog twice, dc in each of the next 3 ch, 2 dc in each of the next 2 ch) 3 times. Dc in each of the next 3 ch, hdc2tog twice, sc in in the next 3 chs, 2 sc in last ch. (48 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn. 2 sc in the 1st st, sc in each of the next 3 sts, hdc2tog twice, (dc in the next 3 sts, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts, dc in each of the next 3 sts, dc2tog twice) 3 times, dc in each of the next 3 sts, 2 dc on top of the ch 3. (48 sts)

Row 3: ch 3, turn. Dc in 1st st, (dc in each of the next 3 sts, dc2tog twice, dc in each of the next 3 sts, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts) 3 times. Dc in each of the next 3 sts, hdc2tog twice, sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in last st. (48 sts)

Row 4- 32 (34): Rpt row 2-3

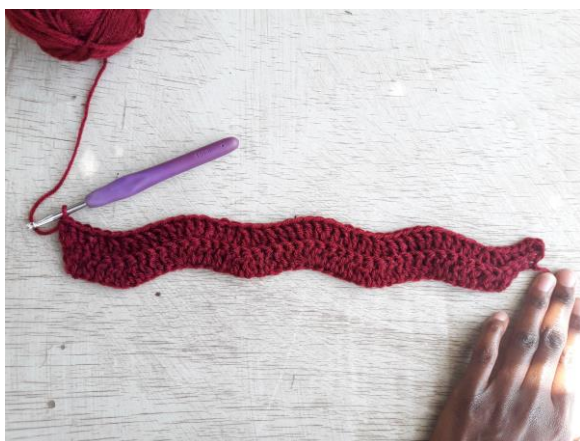
Move to closing & finishing.

Photos.

1. End of row 1



2. End of row 2



3. End of row 3



4. After st rpts



Closing and finishing.

Fold in half lengthwise with the right side facing each other. Sl st last row to beginning row to join them. To best disguise the join, seam is worked only through the chain stitches and the back loop of the adjacent st.



Fasten off leaving a 10 inch tail. Use this tail to sew the top of the beanie closed.
